ABOUT US

Akam Foundation is a youth-led, queer feminist, rights-based organisation in Assam, registered under Section 8 of the Companies Act, 2013, in 2022. Akam means “equality” in the Mising language and reflects our commitment to justice. Our work focuses on gender justice and education, emerging from Project Kitape Katha Koi (2020), which promotes the right to read through community libraries, and Drishti: A Queer Collective (2021), which advances LGBTQIA+ rights in rural Assam and small towns through an intersectional feminist approach.

COMMUNITY MOBILIZATION & ORGANISATION



Through direct engagement and outreach, we mobilise queer and transgender communities in Assam to identify their needs, challenges, and aspirations, co-creating locally grounded solutions. Akam Foundation believes in collective strength, supporting local groups and community-led collectives that drive social action, increase visibility, and form the foundation of a stronger queer movement in Assam.

PROJECT KITAPE KATHA KOI

A Community Library in Ahatguri, Jorhat District that has initiated the Free Library concept during lockdown of Covid-19 pandemic in Jorhat. It serves around 100+ children from 5 villages in the Chenijan area. The Community library focuses on the access to the library for everyone, because in the rural areas of Assam, access to the library has been difficult for people. The library has a collection of 2000+ books and it runs regular library programs like book circulation, reading programs, story telling, book talk etc.



CHANDRAPRABHA SAIKIANI FEMINIST LIBRARY & RESOURCE CENTRE



The Feminist Library in Dibrugarh, inaugurated on 19th March 2023, serves as an anti-discriminatory safe space, a feminist action hub, and a vibrant center for readers. With a collection of 2,000+ books, it engages local communities and the LGBTQIA++ community through activities like dance, drama, music, games, storytelling, read-alouds, and weekly book readings. It also fosters political awareness, creating a space for dialogue and learning among children, adolescents, and adults alike.



ALLYSHIP BUILDING WITH LOCAL INSTITUTES (MOU)

To bring a change, we could not walk alone. To work in solidarity Akam Foundation had signed MoUs with Dispur College, Tinsukia College, West Guwahati College of Education, Digboi Women's College, Manohari Devi Kanoi Girls's College in order to have a long term work relationship and exchanges of resources.



PARTNERSHIP WITH GUWAHATI MARATHON

Akam Foundation had partnered with Guwahati Marathon as a Charity Partner for the Event in Feb, 2024. We had put up a Pop-Up Library cum Stall with illustrated books for everyone as well as badges with different rainbow and book motifs, for engaging with community outreach as well.

LIBRARY OUTREACH TO COMMUNITY

Our Community Library outreach works in local communities across Dibrugarh district, with one active library at Jalan Nagar, Alu Bari village. We engage children aged 3–14 years through activities like storytelling, read-aloud sessions, music, games, dance, drama, and weekly book reading. We have recently started issuing books so children can read at home. The library focuses on improving access to books while supporting children's cognitive and motor skill development. We are expanding to more community spaces and have also supported the setup of Nagarkhelia Gaon Children Library in collaboration with MDKG College.



SOLIDARITY WITH FREE LIBRARY MOVEMENT

Our Free Libraries are a part of the Free Libraries Network, India (FLN). As a member of FLN, we aim to reach out to remote communities and to people who are enthusiastic about books and libraries, contributing to help build a free library movement in India demanding people's policy for free public libraries in India.

We extended our solidarity through hosting workshops, volunteering, and actively engaging regionally to strengthen the free library movement in Assam & north east India.



WORKSHOPS BY AKAM

LIBRARY WORKSHOP



"RIGHT TO READ: PROMOTING INCLUSION IN LIBRARY"

Akam jointly organised the 'Right to Read: Promoting Inclusion in Library', a three day residential workshop with Free Libraries Network in Bosco Institute, Jorhat. 20 participants from different parts of the country joined the workshop. The workshop focused on developing an inclusive curriculum for the library.



"LIBRARY FOR ALL: DELIVERING THE RIGHT TO READ"

Akam hosted Free Libraries Network's 'Library for All: Delivering the Right to Read', a three day residential workshop in Don Bosco Institute, Guwahati. 30 participants from 5 states in India participated in this three day residential workshop. In this workshop, policy development for free libraries in India is one of the main aspects.



PROGRAMMES AT AKAM

YOUTH EXCHANGE PROGRAMS

Youth Exchange Program is an initiative to build young leaders in the educational institutions where the leaders from Drishti Collective handhold the leaders from the educational institutions. We have conducted a 2 days program on leadership development at Dispur College on 12th June, 2023 and Tinsukia College on 2nd and 3rd June 2023. It was facilitated by the leaders of Drishti Collective where sessions were based on identification of issues, community mobilization, stakeholder involvement and advocacy. These programs have been the medium to carry forward gender justice around the educational institutes.



COLLEGE OUTREACH PROGRAMS

College outreach programs are one of the important ways to create awareness in the educational institutions so that the educational institution becomes a safe space for the community. We and Drishti: A Queer Collective together mobilised more than 12,000+ youths within the colleges and Universities of Assam on Gender Sensitization. These outreach programs helped to build notions of gender beyond binary in the educational institutes from different parts of Assam.



Q-DRISHTI : SUMMER SCHOOL ON GENDER

Within the premises of Chandraprabha Saikiani Feminist Library and Resource Centre, a five days extensive workshop on gender and sexuality beyond binary was organised from 23rd June, 2023 to 27th June, 2023. It is a queer youth leadership workshop. The workshop focuses on building vivid perspectives on gender and sexuality beyond binary among the youths of assam. Youths from different parts of Assam participated in the workshop. Every session was based on gender, sexuality, patriarchy, masculinity, social exclusion, intersectionality, relevance of feminism and legal rights.

Dr. Anita Boruah, Dr. Pranjal Buragohain, Dr. Mayuri Sharma Borua, Indranee Kalita, Dr. Debojane Borah were invited as the guest resource persons for the workshop. 23 participants across Assam joined the workshop.
